Greetings from Bolivia. We arrived back safely and have settled back in. Ann Marie is doing well at college and we thank you for the prayers and encouragement you have given. Our boys have gotten back into a daily routine for school and are working hard at their studies. Thank you for your prayers and support and for the ones who have given towards a vehicle and the purchase of a plot of land for the church plant. Would you consider prayerfully giving towards these needs?

The presidential elections finally came. The MAS party, the socialist party, has won. If you remember the unstable situation over the last year when the previous president was run out of the country and an interim president was appointed. To the surprise of many, the party that won the election is the same party represented by the previous president. This socialist party won by a large margin and will transition into power over the next month. Our prayer is that this new leadership of the country will not affect us in our ministry here in Bolivia. We trust the Lord's plan for us, our ministry, and the people here. People need the Gospel. We served God before and we will continue to serve Him. I Corinthians 15:58 tells us to, "be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord."
